- Established in 1970, Family Health Centers of San Diego is a private, non-profit community health center organization. Our mission is to provide caring, affordable, high quality healthcare to anyone in need, with a special commitment uninsured, low income, and medically underserved families.
- Family Health Centers of San Diego is accredited by the Joint Commission on the Accreditation of Health Care Organizations, the nation's predominant healthcare quality standards-setting and accrediting body.
- In 2009, FHCSO provided over 562,000 patient encounters to over 134,000 individuals.
- In 2009, 62% of FHCSO patients were uninsured and 95% had incomes at or below 200% of the federal poverty level.
